**O R D E R**

**WHEREAS**, Florida Rules of Civil Procedure authorize the Chief Judge to appoint a Child Support Enforcement Hearing Officer; and

**WHEREAS**, due to the retirement of Eric Eggen, Child Support Enforcement Hearing Officer there is a need to appoint a Child Support Enforcement Hearing Officer; and

**WHEREAS**, the Department of Revenue through the Office of the State Court Administrator has allocated funding for this position; it is, therefore

**ORDERED** that Debra D. Little, Esquire is hereby appointed to act as Child Support Enforcement Hearing Officer effective May 1, 2011.


Debra D. Little, Esquire will provide professional services to the First Judicial Circuit to establish, enforce or modify child support in cases in which a party seeks support pursuant to Title IV-D of the Social Security Act (42 U.S.C. §§651 et seq.) and in non-Title IV-D cases.

Additionally, Debra D. Little, Esquire shall perform duties under the direction of the Chief Judge, in accordance with Rule 12.491, *Florida Rules of Family Law Procedure*, and other applicable Florida statutes and rules.

The appointment of Debra D. Little, Esquire shall take effect May 1, 2011 and shall

continue until further order of this court.
