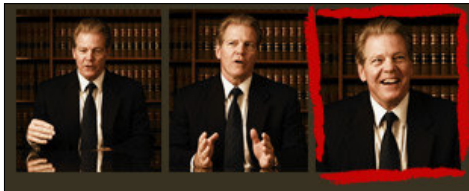
DISCOVER WHAT IS COMING UP!
