**RE: COURT ADMINISTRATION
COURT HOLIDAY CLOSURES - 2022**

WHEREAS pursuant to SCPR 4.07 the courts are mandated to close for business in observance of certain holiday events; and

WHEREAS the undersigned Chief Judge is authorized to designate certain other dates for closure during each calendar year; it is

ORDERED that:

1. The Courts of the First Judicial Circuit will be closed to the public the following calendar dates in the year 2022:

**Friday, December 31, 2021 - Observance of New Year's Day
Monday, January 17, 2022 - Martin Luther King's Birthday
Monday, February 21, 2022 - Presidents' Day
Friday, April 15, 2022 - Good Friday
Monday, May 30, 2022 - Memorial Day
Monday, July 4, 2022 - Independence Day
Monday, September 5, 2022 - Labor Day
Monday, September 26, 2022 - Rosh Hashanah
Wednesday, October 5, 2022 - Yom Kippur
Friday, November 11, 2022 - Veterans Day
Thursday, November 24, 2022 - Thanksgiving Day
Friday, November 25, 2022 - Friday after Thanksgiving Day
Monday, December 26, 2022 - Observance of Christmas Day**

2. Pursuant to §43.26 and §43.27, *Florida Statutes*, all Clerks of the Courts in the First Judicial Circuit must provide appropriate staff in support of the Clerk's official duties and responsibilities to the judicial processes when courts in the First Judicial Circuit are open to the public for business.
